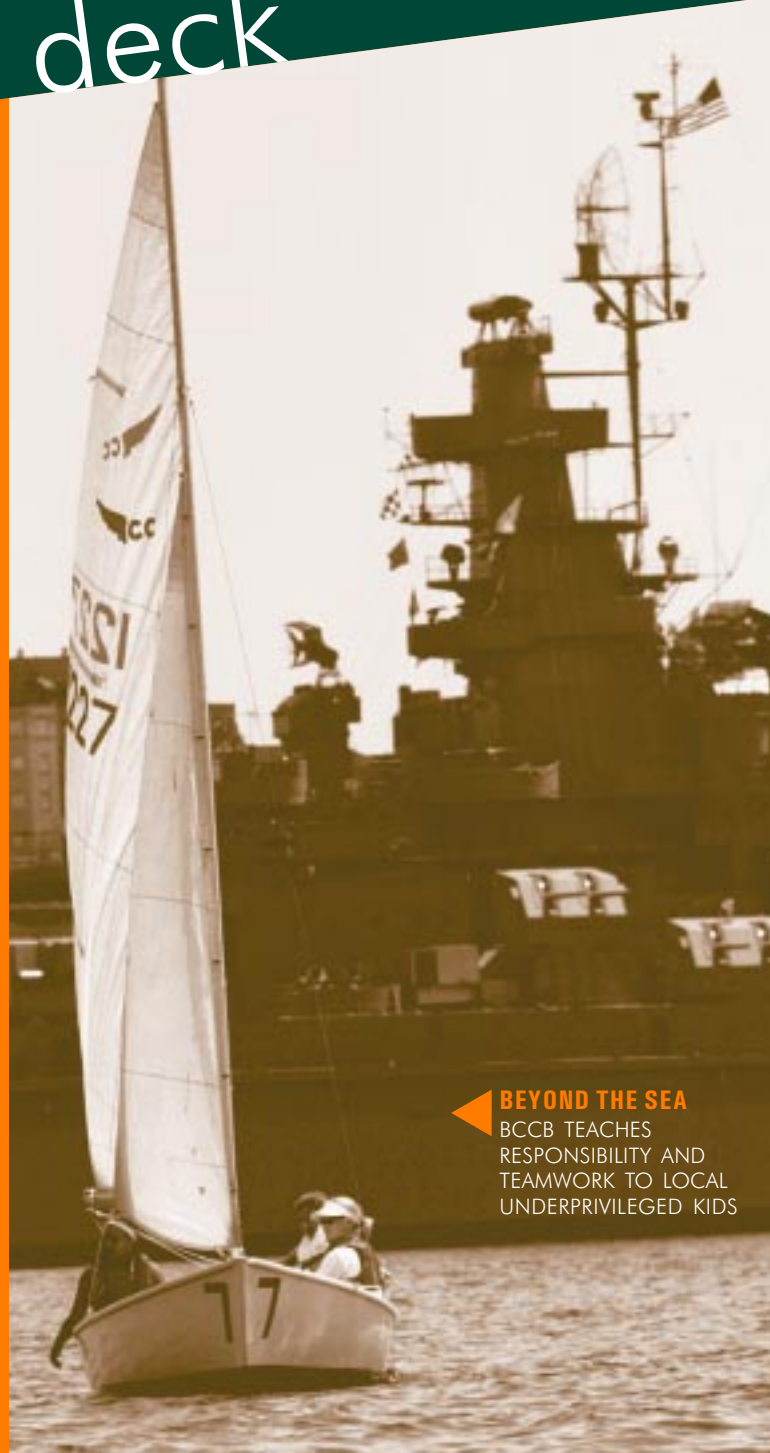
**SAILING FUNDAMENTALS FOR ADULTS**

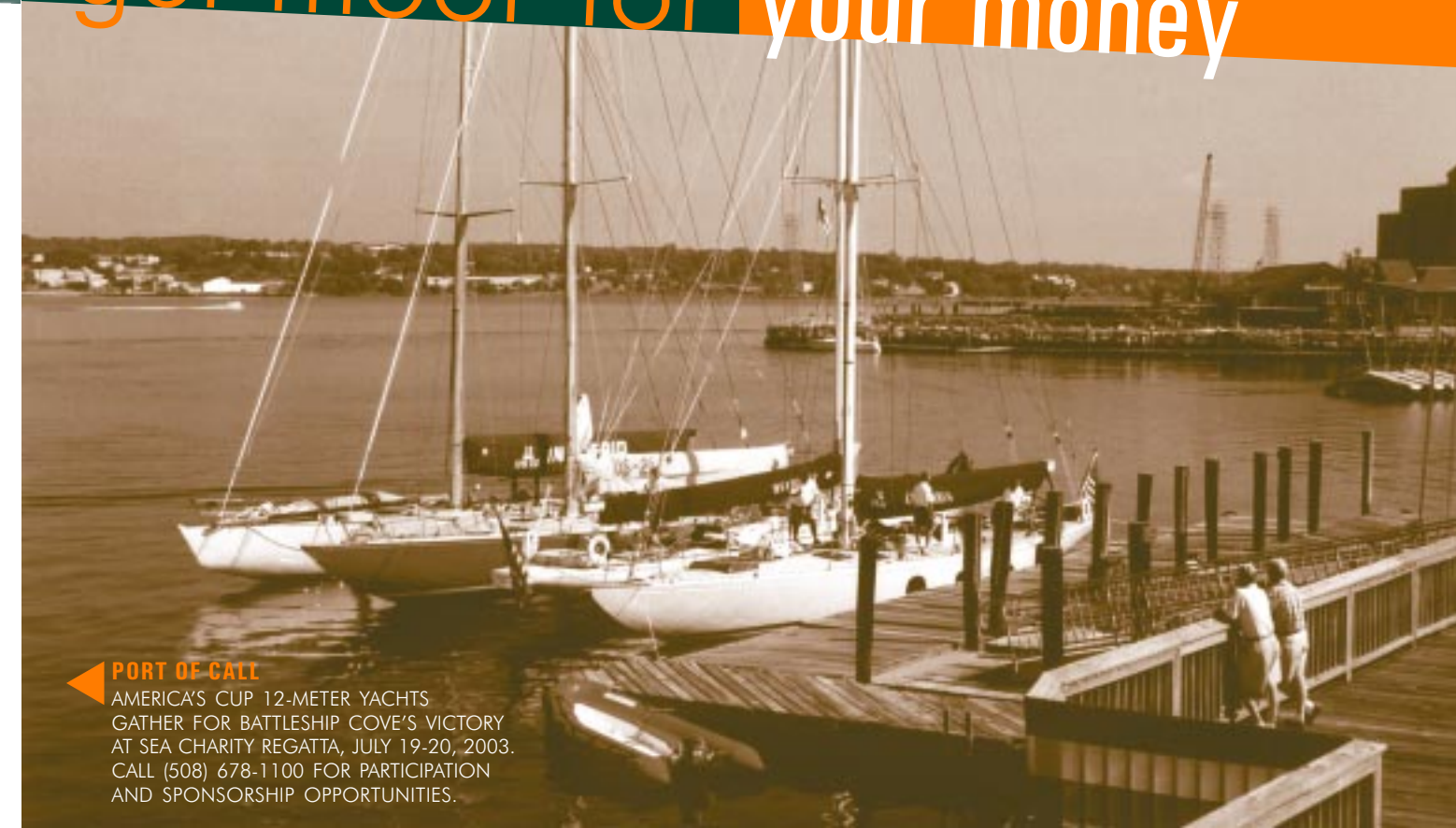
